Myriam Van Imschoot and the vocal ensemble HYOID created newpolyphonies, a vocal performance-concert inspired by the sounds in nature and the world that surround us. A keen listener will hear a lot of different sounds in this work: the roar of aircraft engines, the singing of the grasshopper, the buzzing of bees or flies. It is a subtle journey in a world of sound that reveals how everything in our existence is full of vibrations and frequencies, from the smallest critters, bodies and bones, to the higher spheres.

Four singers of HYOID share the stage with a group of 15 participants, who are open to the bizarre and magical sound world that is the starting point of the artistic work of Myriam van Imschoot.
